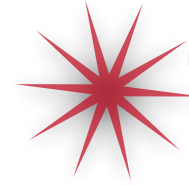

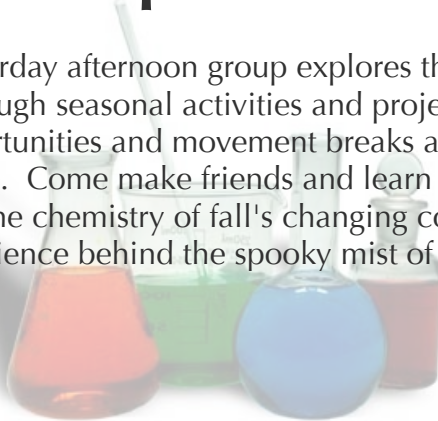

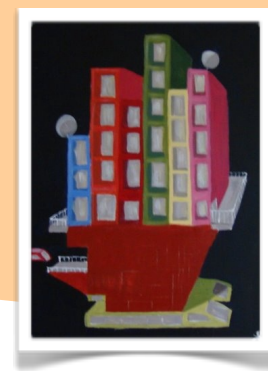

Typically individuals with autism are very visual-spatial and sensory oriented, and so art is a natural vehicle with which to express themselves. Instruction is based on the ever changing passions and talents of each individual.

The Calling All Characters Drama Program

Under the direction of our friends from Tumbleweeds Theatre Company, participants learn the fundamentals of drama and theatre, exploring their perception of the world around them while building self confidence in a supportive, respectful atmosphere. Actors in this program build their skills over time, and gradually take on more challenging and elaborate projects, with opportunities to write their own material and perform at public events and venues. The Calling All Characters troupe have performed in full length productions of Peter Pan and Knights of the Roundtable at theatres including the Metro and the Belfry.



...Did you know?

Drama instruction helps individuals with autism build on their imitative strengths by actually learning, practicing and perfecting "lines". It also creates opportunities to work on social improvisation, reading and using body language, and developing speaking skills.
